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Hello all, Arlo (from 36's) Dad here. On the 28.9.2023 myself and two friends, Gary and Chris, are embarking on a 2000-mile road trip called the 'Skinflint Rally'. We are travelling to Austria and back over a four-day period. We depart on the 28<sup>th</sup> of September, making our way to Folkstone for the Eurotunnel crossing to Calais, where we will continue onto the Island of Lindau at Lake Constance and then onto the Austrian town of Lienz, via the Stelvio pass.

The idea of the Rally is primarily to raise money for various charities. We have purchased a Peugeot 407SW for £410 which we are hoping will survive the journey. The vehicle has been decorated as the Ghost Busters Ecto 1 in an attempt to raise as much interest as possible. This year we are representing and raising money for a local Coventry charity called Archie's Smile. Archie's Smile is a group developed to support families and their children with Down Syndrome. The group was developed and opened in 2015, has seen over 50 families access the group and they support them on their journey with their children towards transition into starting primary school. All money donated will be going directly to Archie's smile to assist them with the crucial development of



the children's speech and language. The group is fully funded through donations and we would like to help them continue with all of their hard work.

I would like to appeal to you all to help us raise as much money as possible, for such a good cause, even if people donate as little as  $\pounds 1$  it would all add up! We will be in school on Monday  $25^{th}$  September with our car and your child will have a chance to graffiti the car with a message of support for this amazing charity!

The weather keeps changing its mind by the hour at the moment, so please do make sure your child always has their coat in school every day even if it looks like bright sunshine first thing! Thank you!



#### Drop off at School and Parking!

Unfortunately, we have had some complaints from neighbouring residents from both Sutton Avenue and Mellowship Road, about inconsiderate parking and - in some places - dangerous parking too. Please can I remind all members of our community to be considerate of our neighbours and think carefully about drop off. If you can park slightly further away from the school gate and walk the rest of the way to the school, that would certainly alleviate some of the congestion directly near to the school gates. Even better still, if you live within walking distance, we would be so grateful if you could establish a walking / scooting / riding routine of coming to school. The children log how they got to school every day and earn badges for arriving on foot, so if you are able to make an amendment to your school arrival and departure routine, the school and our neighbours would be most grateful. We do understand that for some families, coming in the car is unavoidable, but in this instance please do be mindful of parking carefully and considerately.



### Morning Arrival Time

It has come to our attention that some of our children who walk unaccompanied to school, are arriving increasingly early and waiting for quite a prolonged period outside the school gates. Some of our community minded parents, and nearby residents, have contacted the school to express concerns that some of these children may not be behaving safely whilst they wait unaccompanied for the school gates to open. At the start of the school day, staff are in the building setting up for the day ahead, photocopying resources, preparing their lessons and ensuring that school is ready for the children's arrival. Please can I ask that if your child does come to school unaccompanied, that they do not set off too early so that they arrive outside the school gate at the right time - 8.45am - when one of the team, or I, will open the gate. Thank you for your support.
